Judge protects Churches from City's Gay Mandate

"A judge slapped down an attempt by a Wisconsin city to force churches and other religious organizations to abide by and conform to its pro-LGBT agenda - including gender-identity and sexual orientation dictates," reports One-NewsNow. "The city of De Pere, Wisconsin, adopted a 'non-discrimination' ordinance that designated churches [as] 'places of public accommodation,'" WND reported. "The city claimed that any time a church is open to the public - outside the role of a house of worship - it is subject to the ordinance." Not bowing down to the city's aggressive LGBT agenda, Brown County

Judge was violating the United States Constitution by forcing the LGBT agenda upon them. "This unconstitutional ordinance could not go unchallenged," Dacus stated in a recent PJI news release. "These religious organizations stood up for

play or publish teachings and sermons on matters of sexual ethics, divorce or the biological phenomenon that persons are born either male or female - without the City's oppressive restriction." For some time, churches have been subjected to the city's problematic ordinance. "The City's ordinance - passed just before Thanksgiving of last year - addressed non-discrimination of gender identity and sexual orientation in housing, employment, advertising and public accommodations - without as exemption for religious organizations," the PJI release recounted. "Before the ordinance took effect in March 2018, Pacific Justice Institute (PJI) swiftly took action and filed a complaint."

"PJI attorney Kevin Snider said the churches should not have to bow down to local officials' dictates when they violate their faith."

Christian Teacher Fired for refusing Transgender Pronouns

"A teacher at West Point High School in Virginia was fired recently over his religious objections to using male pronouns when referring to a student who is biologically female but identifies as male," reports Townhall. The West Point School Board unanimously voted 5-0 Thursday to dismiss 47-year-old French teacher Peter Vlaming following a four-hour hearing. They argued that he was in 'willful violation of school board policy.' "We do not and cannot tolerate discrimination in any form, or actions that create a hostile environment for any member of our school family," they said in a statement. "Mr. Vlaming was asked repeatedly, over several weeks and by multiple administrators, to address a student by the pronouns with which this student

identifies. The issue before us was not one mistaken slip of the tongue. Mr. Vlaming consistently refused to comply going forward -- including in a statement made at the hearing -- a willful violation of school board policy." Vlaming cited his Christian faith and told his superiors that he was willing to use the student's name and simply avoid using feminine pronouns but he says the school rejected that compromise. "That discrimination then leads to creating a hostile learning environment. And the student had expressed that. The parent had expressed that," West Point Superintendent Laura Abel said regarding Vlaming's insistence on avoiding the student's preferred pronouns. "They felt disrespected." "However, some parents



and students support Vlaming and there is a petition underway entitled 'Don't Terminate Mr. Vlaming' which has 2,632 supporters." --- [Dr. Chaps' comment: Government compelled speech is not free speech.
